We will be supporting the Turning Tides Homeless Project and they have asked us for specific gifts and donations to their cause. These are:

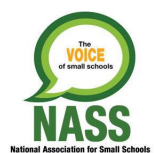
- Pasta / spaghetti / macaroni etc.
